Purpose of the role:

- Respond to unsolicited requests for information from MEs
- Inform and shape medical strategy by collecting impactful insights from MEs
- Collaborate cross-functionally with clinical, commercial, and regulatory teams to ensure alignment and effective delivery of medical information and insights.
- Develop, plan, implement and timely execute field medical tactic & medical engagement plan, aligned with the brand strategy
- Support Novartis clinical research programs, optimize trial execution and provide scientific educational support to potential and actual study sites in collaboration with clinical operations
- Facilitate Investigator Initiated Trial (IIT) process upon investigator request
- Serve as a medical resource to field matrix colleagues

- MD, PharmaD or PhD degree in health/life sciences with solid medical/technical background and expertise knowledge in respective scientific area
- Business fluent in German and English is critical for the role, knowledge of French is an important asset, other languages are a plus

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
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
